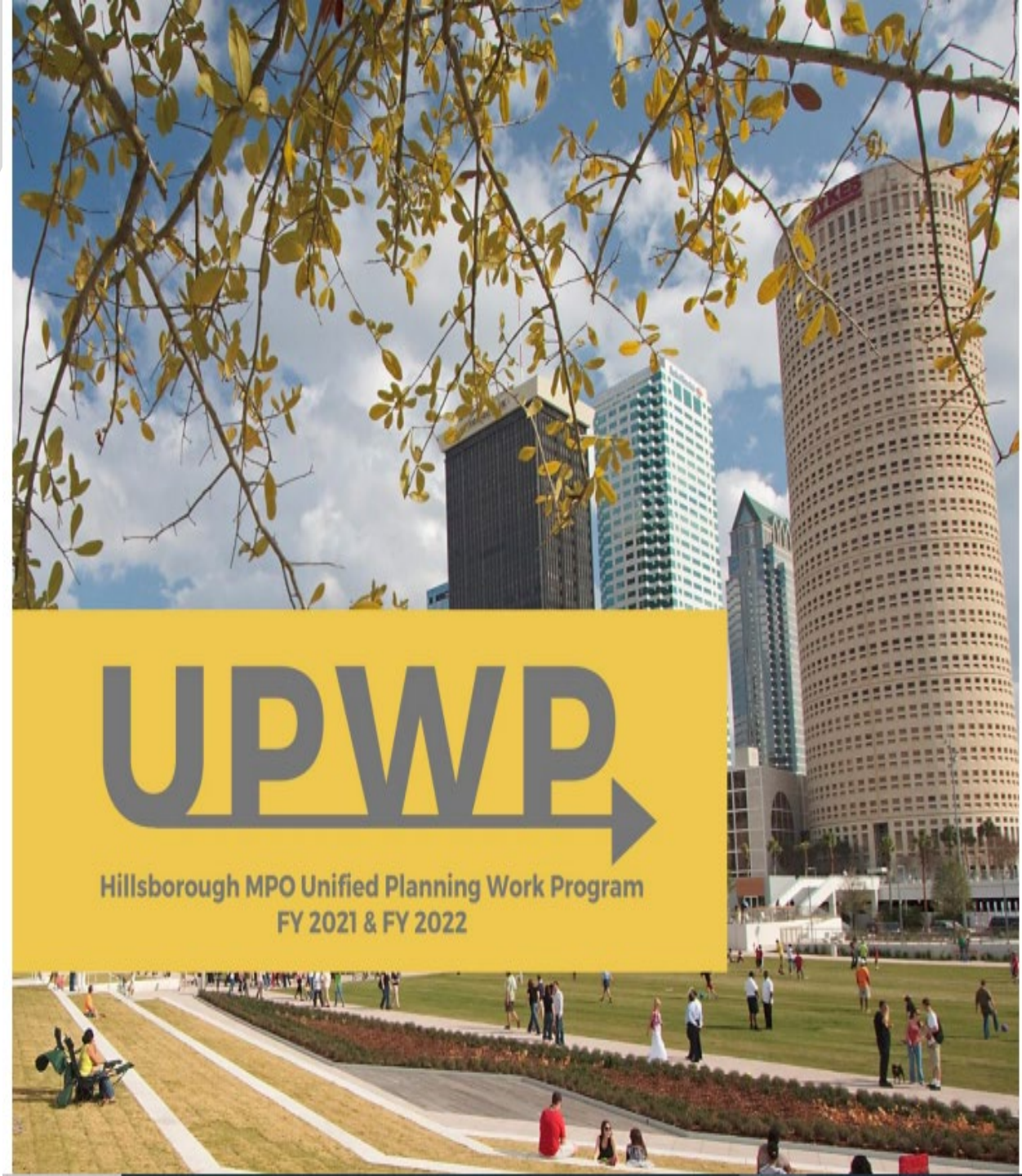

- 2-year work program
- Effective July 1, 2020 – June 30, 2022
- Outlines major planning tasks
- Documents federal & state funding
- Coordinates federally funded planning tasks performed by the TPO, HART, & FDOT
- Complies with federal & state rules

Truing up the grant budgets at fiscal year-end

- SU (Surface Transportation Block Grant) \$0
 - Shifting available dollars from Task 3 to task 2
- FTA Grant decrease of from a total federal, state, local dollars of \$659,219 to \$514,953.
 - Updating standard annual documentation (FTA SF 424, Certifications and Assurances for FY 2022)
 - Last year's actual available funding was \$527,375 and this year is \$514,953
- No change in work products

Funding allocated annually.

* Dollar change is in federal dollars, State offers soft match and not spendable dollars.



New Grant Funds: State Transportation Innovation Council (STIC)

- \$15,085 for new air quality monitors (equipment purchase)
- TPO applied and was awarded a grant through State Transportation Innovation Council (STIC)
- Implements the board's May action to work with EPC and USF to create a grassroots network for air quality monitoring using new low-cost sensors



Supporting statewide planning for passenger rail

- FL MPO Advisory Council's (MPOAC's) Freight Committee has an expanded mission to address passenger rail priorities and have a voice in State Rail Plan
- MPOAC proposes a MPO-focused workshop on passenger rail, plus more steps
- Typical for larger MPOs to sponsor strategic efforts; most of the Freight Committee's work has been sponsored by Broward MPO
- We propose \$15,000 to assist this MPOAC project
- No impact on our other tasks

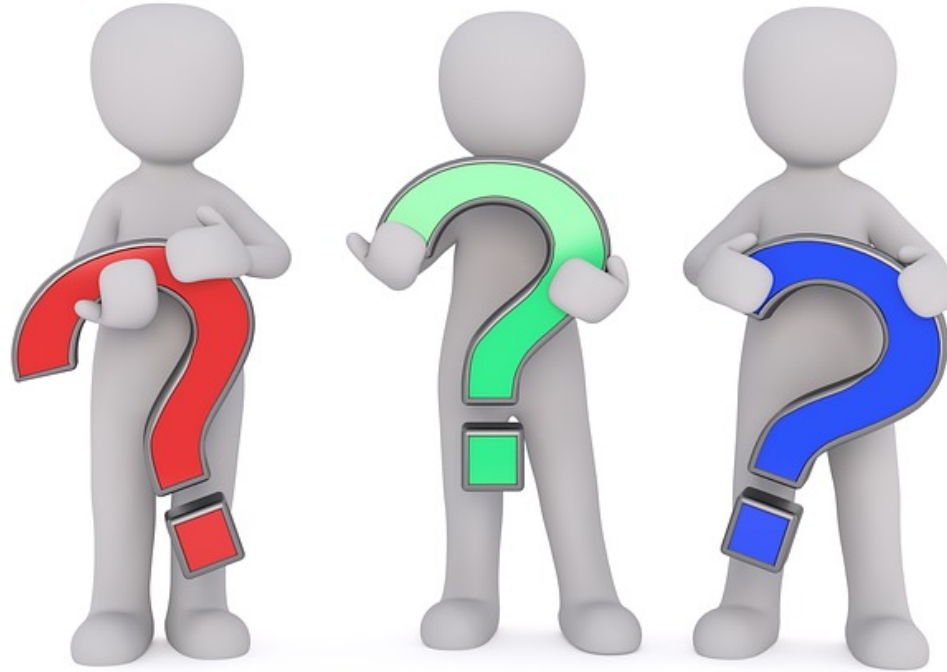


Recommended Action:
