Rapid implementation of Vision Zero priorities








- Data-driven: Use data to clearly define the problem

2022: SAFE STREETS FOR ALL APPLICATION




- ▶ Tampa-Systemic Applications for Equity (T-SAFE)
- ▶\$25M requested
- ▶ Safe Routes to School, Parks, and Transit
- ▶ 74% of funding towards roads in underserved communities

Projects include:

- New sidewalks and bike lanes
- New pedestrian crossings
- Upgraded streetlighting
- ► Speed Management
